Northern Virginia's and suburban Washington's oldest public high school, Washington-Lee, opened its doors in 1922. Then, the county was typical of those that surrounded the "Sleepy Southern town," pre-World War II Washington, DC. Wartime growth and waves of foreign immigration since the mid-seventies have dramatically altered the landscape and culture of the Washington, DC region. Washington-Lee High School evolved along with the region.

In 2009, Arlington County dedicated a brand new, state-of-the-art facility for Washington-Lee High School and demolished the old facility.
